This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students achieving A-C in English from 69.6% to 80%.
- Increase the percentage of students achieving A/B in English from 30.7% to 35%.
- Increase the percentage of students achieving A-C in Math from 77.4% to 85%.
- Increase the percentage of students achieving A/B in Math from 38% to 45%.
- Increase the attendance rate of students from 87.4% to 92%.

Our initiatives include

- Exploring the research of Lyn Sharratt to increase the engagement and achievement for all students through a **learning collaborative** with other schools in our region.
- Support **student engagement and learning** through individually adjusted learning tasks and environments.
- Supporting students with **social emotional needs** through **Pathways to Resilience** and **Friendology programs**.
- Collegial conversations to support student engagement and learning through a **case management** approach.
- Teaching and learning supported in year level sectors by **Teaching and Learning Champions**.

- Employing full time Engagement Teacher Aide - \$40,856
- Employing additional Teaching and Learning Champion - \$121,780
- Purchase learning resources to support programs - \$852
