Daisy Hill State School will receive

**\$159,122\***

## This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students Prep – Year 2 achieving A-C in English from 57% to 70%.
- Increase the percentage of students in Year 1-2 achieving year level expectations in reading from 58% to 70%.
- Increase language and cognitive skills in early years in response to AEDC– at risk 29.3% & vulnerable from 10.3%.

## Our initiatives include

- Supporting early literacy development through the **Early Learning & Literacy Program**.
- Exploring the research of Lyn Sharratt to increase the growth and achievement in all students through a **learning collaborative** with other schools in our region.
- Creating procedures to develop a deep understanding of the literacy demands of the **Australian Curriculum**.
- Exploring **age appropriate pedagogies** to develop early literacy skills.
- Supporting early reading through Fountas & Pinnell **Levelled Literacy Intervention**.

## Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Employing full time Early Years Coach / Intervention Leader. (\$120 082)
- Employing Early Years intervention teacher / teacher aide. (\$36 490)
- Purchasing Early Learning & Literacy Program resources. (\$2 550)
